

## **Race Day Action**

5:00 a.m. - Buses load up in the dark for Saylorville Dam

7:00 a.m. - 20k starts with a view of the downtown

8:15 a.m. - Music, food & Festivities at the finish area

9:45 a.m. - 20k very short award ceremony

11:00 a.m. - Finish line closes

12:00 noon - the last DAM race is done

## **Race Instructions**

- Race Bib - wear your assigned race number. Dam race rules prohibit running with a number not
  assigned to you. You must have a race bib to board the buses, run on the course, enter the finish area
  and to receive a finisher medal.
- Buses - the only way to get to the start. Buses leave from Downtown, Merle Hay Mall and DMACC
  Ankeny campus at 5 a.m. to 5:45 a.m. There is no vechicle parking or drop off parking at Saylorville
  Dam. No bags are allowed on the buses.
- Start Area - at the start there are over 150 portable toilets. Water is available but bringing your own is advisable. No bag drop service is provided.
- 7 a.m. Start - no early starts, dogs, bikes, baby joggers, etc allowed. Please line up on the Saylorville
   Dam according to pace, be fair.
- <u>Course</u> - is well monitored, every mile marked and 8 water stations. Each water station has portable toilets. The course is open: 10 kilometer 9:00 a.m., 10 miles 10:00 a.m. and finish 11:00 a.m.
- <u>Finish</u> - adjacent to Cowles Commons with all finishers receiving the last DAM medal. Water and Powerade located in the finish line area. Food & refreshments are on 3rd Street and Walnut Avenue.
   Be prepared to show photo ID to receive alcohol.
- <u>Showers</u> - avaible at the YMCA, 5th & Grand. Show your race bib to front desk & bring your own towel.
- Results - streamed at damtodam.com and posted on the Capital Square building near the exit of the finish area. Age Division winners (gun time) pick up your award at the tent on the west end of Cowles Common adjacent to posted results.
- <u>Spectators</u> - can take a Farmer's Market shuttle from Capitol area. There is a bike valet at 2nd & Court. See dsmpartnership.com/desmoinesfarmersmarket/directions-parking for further information.
